Disposing of human remains other than in accordance with The Cemeteries Act, 1999

At the request of a family, an owner proceeded to bury the deceased on the family farm, which was not a registered cemetery in accordance with *The Cemeteries Act, 1999*. Following the interment, the family did in fact make application to have a cemetery registered and approval was subsequently granted.

The owner stated he had proceeded with the family's request after making cursory enquiries, but acknowledged the incorrect advice he had provided the family placed them in potential violation of eight sections of *The Cemeteries Act, 1999*.

The owner appeared before a Discipline Committee and joint statement of facts and an agreed sanction was presented. As a consequence, the Discipline Committee made an Order for a reprimand, and a fine of \$5,000
