2014 On-line License Renewal

Just a reminder the 2014 license renewals are due at Council office no later than midnight Saturday, November 30, 2013.

In order to renew your license, please visit our website at www.funeralinfo.ca and log in. Once you have successfully logged in to Council's website please click on Submission Forms and the Funeral Director/Embalmer/Salesperson License Renewal Form. In addition, please remember that your continuing education credits must be entered prior to submitting your on-line renewal. Failure to do so will result being unable to access the on-line renewal form.

Also noteworthy, a number of inquiries have been received by Council administration with regards to signing in to Council's website. Please remember that when entering your user name it is your designation followed by a space and then your designation number (for example: EFDS 0001).

As always should you experience any difficulties, please do not hesitate to contact Council administration.

Compliance Update

Since January 1st, 2013 there have been 79 compliance reviews completed and 24 complaints received. Ten complaints have been received from consumers and 14 received from other sources.
